



Corridor programme: Combining forces




- Working on long term Corridoragenda 2030, with actions on:
 - Policy making for developping multimodal nodes for business (DC, EDC's, Industry and the freight transport sector and thereby focussing on rail, waterways, pipelines and road)
 - Modal shift through nodes leading to CO2 reduction and shifting freight from road to other modes of transport by different policy actions
 - Enhancing the development of clean energy hubs in the corridors
 - Robustness for waterway transport (low water depths and alternative routes) and railroads
 - Enhancing the use of digital data platforms
 - Clear strategy within a timeframe for investing in several perspectives
- Working on a combined budget shared by partners for realizing topcorridors








Actions linked to sustainabilty

- Chain optimization with enhancing call sizes containers inland shipping
- Modal shift subsidy program for shifting toward water and rail (M€ 40)
- Stimulating building business parks near multimodal locations
- Subsidy program developing quay walls as enabler transport by water (M€ 10)
- Investing in shore power locations (M€ 16)
- Joint approach Corridors on CEF-calls (Rhombus)
- Zero Emmission Services (ZES)
- Enabling Clean Energy Hubs










Which way to: what, where, when, who?

For determining locations 3 search directions :

- 1. Electric charging / Batteries
- 2. Alternative fuels:
 - Liquid fuels -> synthetic oils / bio-diesel
 - Gasses -> LNG / CNG, etc
